

## Updated emergency information

It is crucial that the school has the latest mobile phone numbers, emergency contacts and health care information. #### Attendance

It is most important that students attend school each and every day unless they are sick or have genuine reasons for non attendance. The same goes for arriving late at school. Records are kept of late arrivals and this counts as partial attendance only. Written explanation of absences are required when students are absent.

## It's cool at school...

Despite the uncomfortable weather conditions at the moment the school is well equipped to have all students housed in an air conditioned room. There are also restrictions on going into the playground in extreme weather. Most often the children are better off at school than at home. Their wellbeing is paramount when at their place of learning.

## **School Hours**

The school provides supervision from 8:25am each morning. You are reminded that the students should not be arriving at school earlier than this

time to ensure their safety and wellbeing. The school day finishes for students at 2:55pm. Parents or adults collecting students are asked to be at school on time to collect the children.


## Stephanie Alexander Kitchen Garden

The Emerton Public School community has been given the opportunity to participate in the Song Room arts and music program to encourage Indigenous parents and communities to become more involved with local schools and organisations.


Research shows that high levels of parental and community involvement are strongly related to improving students' education and social outcomes.
